Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

The committee substitute to SB 652 further clarifies the reduced number of election dates available for holding local elections. The measure would also further clarify and reduce the election dates for holding a special election called by the Governor. SB 652 would also modify the scheduling of a candidacy filing period to fill a vacancy within a municipality, school district or political subdivision. The 3-day candidate filing period would now be required to begin not more than 10 days following the date the resolution calling the election is required to be filed with the secretary of the county election board. The Oklahoma State Election Board states the necessary updates to the management system and election materials would cost less than \$10,000 and could be absorbed by the Board. The Board also notes the possibility of cost savings for local entities due to the reduced election dates, however the Board is unable to estimate those savings at this time.
